7. Discuss, consider and take appropriate action to designate a location to temporarily build a community volleyball court; authorizing the use of City funds to purchase materials and supplies; authorizing the use of City staff for installation purposes; and any other matters incident thereto.

Background:

The City of El Cenizo seeks to establish a temporary volleyball court to provide residents, youth, and families with a safe and engaging recreational activity. This initiative supports the City's efforts to promote wellness, community engagement, and active living. The proposed court will be constructed using City staff and funded through available Parks & Recreation or General Fund resources. City Management Team will identify a suitable temporary location that is accessible to the public and does not interfere with ongoing operations or future planned improvements.

Fiscal Impact:

Materials and supplies will be purchased using available City funds, not to exceed \$2,500.00. Labor will be provided by City staff under the supervision of the Public Works Department.

Recommendation:

City Management Team recommends approval of the proposed temporary volleyball court, authorization to use City funds for materials and supplies, and approval to utilize City staff for installation and maintenance purposes.

8. Discuss, consider and take appropriate action to authorize the purchase of 25 (twenty-five) 96-gallon trash bins for the City's Solid Waste Collection Department from any of the following vendors; and any other matters incident thereto.

Background:

The Solid Waste Collection Department is requesting authorization to purchase new 96-gallon trash bins to replace damaged containers currently in circulation and to provide additional bins for new customers. The new bins will improve efficiency, safety, and sanitation within the City's residential waste collection program.

Fiscal Impact:

Funds for this purchase are available in the Solid Waste Fund under Materials and Supplies.

Recommendation:

City Administration recommends approval of this item and authorization for the City Management Team to proceed with the purchase of the 96-gallon trash bins, in accordance with applicable procurement policies.
