RESOLUTION NO. 2025-0602-B**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL CENIZO, TEXAS, MODIFYING THE REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING SCHEDULE FROM THE FOURTH THURSDAY TO THE SECOND MONDAY OF EACH MONTH AT 6:30 P.M. TO BE HELD AT THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS LOCATED AT EL CENIZO CITY HALL; AUTHORIZING THE CALLING OF EMERGENCY AND SPECIAL MEETINGS AS DEEMED NECESSARY AND APPROPRIATE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TEXAS OPEN MEETINGS ACT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of El Cenizo, Texas, desires to ensure efficient, transparent, and accessible governance for its residents; and

WHEREAS, the City Council seeks to revise its regular meeting schedule to improve participation and align with city operations; and

WHEREAS, under the Texas Open Meetings Act (Chapter 551, Texas Government Code), the City Council is authorized to establish regular meeting times and locations and to call Emergency or Special Meetings when necessary;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL CENIZO, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1. The regular meetings of the City Council shall be held on the **second Monday of each month at 6:30 p.m.** in the **Council Chambers located inside El Cenizo City Hall.**

SECTION 2. The Mayor or a majority of the City Council is authorized to call **Emergency Meetings** and **Special Meetings** in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, provided that all required notices and procedures are followed.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this resolution is held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
